DATA COLLECTION

Title VI Civil Rights Act of 1964

Under Title VI Civil Rights Act of 1964 recipients of Rural Development assistance must maintain, for compliance review and discrimination complaint investigation purposes by Rural Development and other appropriate agencies, various types of data by race and national origin. The recipient must maintain this data to show the extent to which, members of protected groups are participants and beneficiaries of the Rural Development assisted program.
